

Tuesday, May 5th

PK3

Religion: We will be reciting the “Hail Mary” and learning again the motions and words to help us to better remember our “Angel of God” prayer. Also, we will be learning the story as to how Jesus called the little children to come to Him “for the Kingdom of God is theirs.” We will explore this in our teaching video. We will connect this to our last Mass when we were together and all of the children received their special blessing on the top of their heads by Father Paul. ELA: Continue to learn more about the sound of Y. We will review Jolly Phonics. We will cover the letters P, N, C and K. We will learn our sounds with props and songs. Please watch this YouTube video that Mrs. Wilder found for “us!”

Math: We will practice counting to ten, this time including the number “zero” which means “nothing.” Please complete related Seesaw activity.

Science/Social Studies: Let’s learn about what a plant needs to survive. In our video we will learn how water, soil, sunshine and loving care (either by people or by God) are needed for the plant’s survival. Please complete the related Seesaw activity.

Physical Activity: Pillow Case Race: Find an area 20 feet long inside your home. Have a starting line and a cone/object to go around that is 20 feet away. No shoes needed. Put your feet inside of a pillow case and hold the sides. Hop with your feet together around the cone/object and back to the starting line. Time yourself and repeat 2 times to try to improve your score.

PK4

Religion: Continue learning the Hail Mary. Practice the first part of the prayer.

Math: Count to 100 by 1’s and 10’s. On Seesaw complete the Finish the Bug Pattern activity. Practice writing the numbers 1-12.

1. FACT #4: The first Disneyland admission ticket ever sold was purchased for \$1 in 1955. *Think and discuss: Do you like going to amusement parks such as Six Flags Great America, Disney World or Land or even the zoos? Guess how much an admission ticket would cost to get in and tell your parents. Maybe they'll look up the costs and tell you the final answer!*
2. FACT #5: Covering nearly 40 square miles, Walt Disney World resort in Florida is about the size of San Francisco or 2 Manhattan Islands. *Think and discuss: Lots of places can be overwhelming and seem huge! Can you think of a place where your parents may have told you several times to "Stay close" or "Hold my hand" because it was so busy and crowded? Have you ever been lost?*
3. FACT #6: Walt Disney borrowed most of the \$1.5 million needed to make Snow White and The Seven Dwarfs. It took 3 years to complete and become the highest grossing sound film of its time. *Think and discuss: Sometimes it takes a lot of money to make or buy the things we want. Think of a time when you had to save up money for something special you wanted. Was it worth it? Do you still have it?*
4. Watch the tour of Walt Disney World and follow along with the Disney Sing-A-Long and see how many Disney characters you can name!
