

Wednesday, April 22nd

### **PK3**

**Religion:** Practice the “Angel of God” Prayer as recently taught through our videos. “Angel of God, my Guardian Dear, to whom God’s love commits me here. Ever this day be at my side, to light and guard, to rule and guide.” Point to the side of your body for the part, “Be at my side” to help you to remember that part of the prayer better.

**ELA:** In our morning video I will show you how to draw a “Yellow Submarine” on the next work page of your journal. We will draw a horizontal oval which will be our submarine and then we will draw 17 circles inside to stand for the windows where all 14 preschoolers can look out, plus three extra for Mrs.Swartzle, Mrs.Wilder and for Ms. Rachel to look out from. We will color it yellow and color blue in the background to stand for the water. We will try to draw a triangle to act as the sailboat.

**Math:** There will be a Seesaw activity that has your child learn how to count zoo animals. More specific directions for this will come in a separate email.

**Science/Social Studies:** Practice holding a heavy object with both hands and then saying “heavy, it weighs a lot.” Practice holding a very light object and saying, “light as a feather.” Look around your home for a way to make a simple instrument, such as a drum, made from a tupperware container being struck with a spoon to allow for sound and rhythm practice.
