

Wednesday, April 15th

PK3

Religion: Please make sure to practice the “Hail Mary” as shown in daily video. It is very important to pray each day to Mary, God, Guardian Angel and to Jesus Himself..who proved Himself as Savior, to protect and save all.

ELA: Try to learn how to be absolutely quiet for 5 whole minutes. (This will serve to help parents and children both. Being quiet for even a short time quiets our minds and allows us to be still within.) Parents, please set five minute timers. It will also, consecutively, teach your child about the sense of time. Thank you for helping..

Math: Continue to practice with taking a large group of unrelated things and counting them to the total (sum) of the number 20. In tomorrow’s daily video we will learn to separate these objects even more so.

Science/Social Studies Please have your Get Along character and your Gentle Lamb character continue to ask questions of each other and talk about sharing and being gentle. Make sure that they use nice eye contact and that they look at each other face to face. This will be demonstrated in tomorrow;s daily video as reinforcement.

Physical Activity: Touch your toes and reach for the sky 10 times. Hop up and down like a bunny rabbit 20 times. Do 20 jumping jacks. Start with hands on the floor and do 10 frog jumps.
