

Tuesday, May 12th

PK3

Religion: Continue to practice saying the “Hail Mary” and the “Angel of God” prayer. We will be practicing both of these in our morning video.

ELA: In our journals we will draw a striped cat sleeping underneath the letters, “ZZZZZ.”

This is the last adventure of Little Bitsy Mousie and she carefully avoids waking up the sleeping cat who is just around the corner. I will demonstrate how to draw a simple cat using ovals, circles, triangles and rectangles. Your parent will need to help you to dot out these basic shapes and then you can connect the dots to create the cat. Please take a picture of your sleeping cat and post it on Seesaw. We will also review the sounds of L, F and B which relate back to our Jolly Phonics program using simple props.

Math: We are going to review counting 25 objects, using five different groupings of five items with similar characteristics. We will then combine all 25 objects into a main container and then re-sort the items into their five “same characteristic” piles. This will be demonstrated through the video. (For example, you might have a group of five balls, a group of five spoons, a group of five action figures, a group of five Leggos and a group of five blocks.)

Science/Social Studies: We will have a two-fold science lesson in our video. First we will celebrate that today will be the day that our Monarch butterfly will emerge from its chrysalis.

There will be a special surprise relating back to that idea. (Hint: It will be a GIGANTIC

I will also begin to teach you about the life cycle of a frog.

Physical Activity: Flip Your Lid: Get a big, flat spatula and a 3-6 inch plastic lid. Stand by a table and place the lid right side up on the spatula. PK4

Religion: Continue practicing The Hail Mary.

Math: Count to 100 by 1’s and by 10’s. On Seesaw to the creating with shapes activity.

Science/Social Studies: Log into letsfindout.com. Read/listen to the “Taking care of baby” issue and complete the last page of the issue.

Physical Activity: Flip Your Lid: Get a big, flat spatula and a 3-6 inch plastic lid. Stand by a table and place the lid right side up on the spatula. Try to flip the lid off the spatula onto the

table. If it lands upside down, you get 2 points. If it lands right side up, you get 1 point. If it falls on the floor, you get 0 points. You have 1 minute. Try it 2 times and try to beat your score!
