PK3

Religion: Please continue to practice the “Angel of God” prayer. In our daily video we will review this prayer and we will continue to practice the “Hail Mary.” Please watch the following YouTube video that pertains to our Blessed Mother.

ELA: Our Jolly Phonics review will include doubled letters ie, ee and or. We will use props to review these sounds. We will delve further into the sound of Z. Please complete the Seesaw activity about the letter Z.

Math: We will learn about the term “pairs.” I will show you how to pair shoes and other items. Please look around your home for pairs of shoes, of socks, of anything! Please do the Shapes Activity on Seesaw.

Science/Social Studies: We will continue to learn more about the life cycle of the frog in our video. We will learn about algae, plants that live in the water that tadpoles eat in order to transform into frogs. I will demonstrate how to draw a simple tadpole in our journals and we will label its eyes, gills, mouth and tail. Please watch today’s teaching video showing you how to do so. Then post your picture on Seesaw, if possible. I also plan to teach you a mini lesson about ocean animals that were rescued after an oil spill. Good hearted people helped to rescue the animals who were soaked in oil, especially the birds and the otters. Dawn dish soap was used to clean these babies and to help to save their lives!
