

Monday, April 27th

### **PK3**

**Religion:** We will continue to practice the “Angel of God” prayer learning motions through our morning videos to help the children to remember the words better. Why is it important to you to know that you have an angel chosen just for you who will be by your side at all times?

**ELA:** This week we are going to be learning about the sound of X. In our journals please draw a large capital X with a lowercase x next to it. Trace over it with three different colors of crayon. We will connect this to Jolly Phonics in our video, about the bear who needs an X ray taken of his arm. Please watch this two minute long YouTube video about the letter X.

**Math:** We will be exploring the concept of “more than and less than.” In our morning lesson we will look at two groups of seashells. We will count each group and then decide which group has more and which has less. Practice counting to ten with ten objects at home, then split those ten objects into a “more pile” and a “less pile.” Count each pile afterwards.

**Science/Social Studies:** Continue to practice with your two stuffed animals giving compliments to each other. Have them use eye contact. Also have your two stuffed animals practice asking each other questions and answering questions about what they want to play today. Then have your two animals play. Have the animals use their manners and use the words “please” and “thank you.”
