

Tuesday, March 17th:

PK3

Religion: Children should draw a shamrock in their journals by drawing three circles either freehand or by tracing a circular object like a cup. Color the shamrock green and add a stem. Parents please explain that the shamrock is symbolic of the Holy Trinity and that each leaf stands for a different part of the Trinity. That is, one leaf stands for God the Father, one leaf stands for the Son, and one leaf stands for the Holy Spirit...but that they are all part of the same plant, just as God, the son and the Holy Spirit are all connected. Have your child practice making the Sign of the Cross and practice saying the Our Father as well.

ELA: Sing the alphabet through two times, the second time pausing at the letter R. Brainstorm or search around your home with your child for words that begin with the sound of r. Have your child color the Little Bitty Mousie picture (in work packet), using red and green and brown for the thorns.

Math: Count how many pairs of shoes you can find in your house.

Science/Social Studies: Take a walk around the block with your family and notice the different animals.

Physical Activity: Do 15 jumping jacks.

PK4

Religion: Say a special prayer for prayer pal. Start to work on one of the Allelu lessons. The Allelu can be done throughout the week.

ELA: Draw 2 items that begin with the letter T.

Math: Find different objects at home that are green. Count how many green objects you find.

Science/Social Studies: Work on "Have You Seen Green" weekly reader. You can go online to view the weekly reader and do other activities with your child.
