PRESCHOOL CORNER

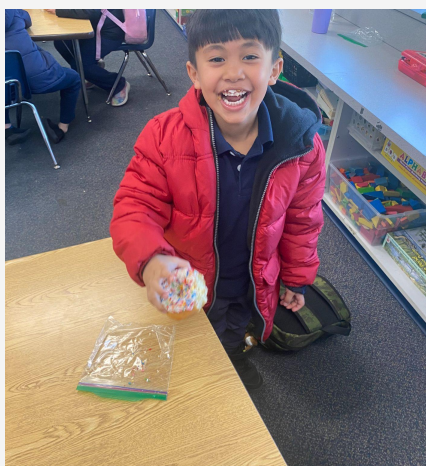

Team Building

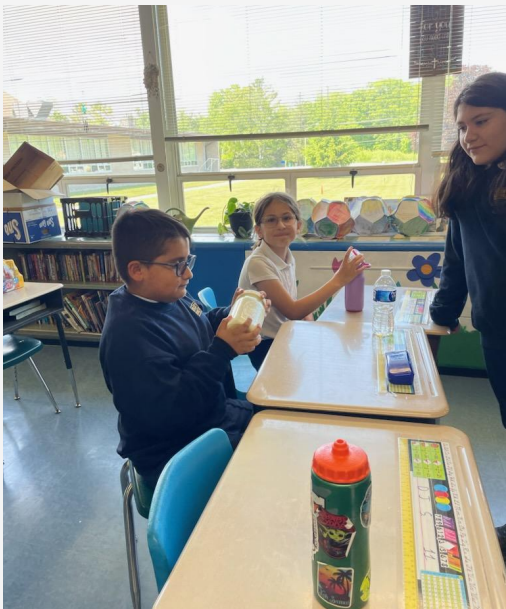
As spring comes around, students look forward to summer. Our third graders spent some time outdoors practicing team building activities as they prepare to be 4th graders in the fall.

Each year our 4th grade class studies Western Expansion with some fun activities to learn more about what life was like then. They love the making butter to finish the Pioneer Unit.

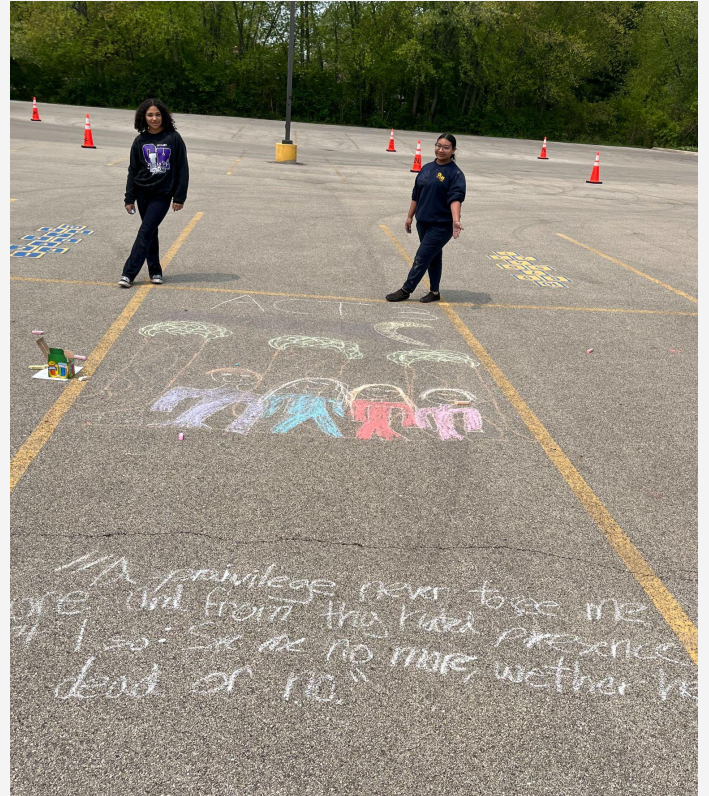


5TH GRADE

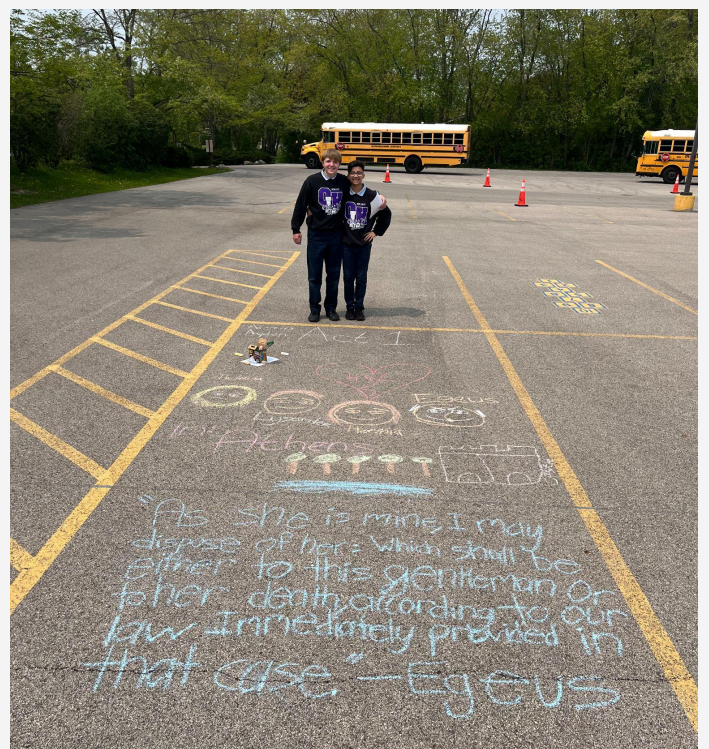
With the nice weather 5th grade took their lessons outside for O Day in our ABC Countdown - Outside Observations.
